Consequently, a personal relationship with God can only be established by:

- accepting what Jesus Christ did on the cross.12
- asking Him to forgive you for your sins.<sup>13</sup>
- letting Him be the Lord and God of your life.<sup>14</sup>
- with Him living inside of you,<sup>15</sup> turning away from whatever God and the Bible call sin. 16



firmly believe all of the major doctrines taught in the Catholic Bible. The foremost of these doctrines is the way the Bible describes how to get to heaven.¹ Even though this is the Bible's primary teaching, I have found that many Catholics are not 100% sure they are going to heaven.

- is a member of a church<sup>6</sup>

- goes to Mass<sup>7</sup>
- receives Holy Communion<sup>8</sup>
- goes to Confession<sup>9</sup>
- prays to Mary<sup>10</sup>
- or does any other form of human effort

The Catholic Bible says that none of these things will get someone into heaven. Both the Catholic and Protestant Bibles clearly teach that there is no person on earth who deserves to go to heaven. It have never deserved, nor will I ever deserve to go to heaven. But, I am going. Like all human beings, I deserve to go to hell because of the sins I have committed. But because of God's wonderful provision, I am 100% positive that I will live with God forever.

How about you? Are you absolutely certain that if you died this moment you would go to heaven? Well, you can be. I believe that you have probably heard the Bible's description of how to get to heaven many times. But just like me, though you've heard it, it was probably never clearly explained to you.
